

Welcome to Bradley Stoke Wise Owls Club

Bradley Stoke Wise Owls Club aims to provide a unique service to the local community. Rather than just providing child care for parents who work, a wide range of activities will be on offer for the children to take part in after school and during holidays.

There is an educational aspect to the club too, where children will receive half an hour group tuition in Maths and English from a qualified teacher.

Located within the Jubilee Centre, the Woodlands Suite provides a spacious, stimulating and secure environment. The purpose built space is ideal for the promotion of children's development and learning out of school. There is a large amount of room both indoors and out for the children to play and have fun.

At the centre of Bradley Stoke, the Jubilee Centre really is at the heart of the local community. It is easily accessible from Brook Way onto Savages Wood Road and ample car parking is available. A pickup service from local schools will be available after school Monday to Friday.

As well as structured arts and crafts sessions and study time there will be a selection of free choice activities.

Children will also be involved in the preparation of their own healthy snacks.





Arts and Crafts and Study Support

Wise Owls promotes children's development and learning out of school. Whilst at the club the children will receive half an hour group tuition in either Maths or English or will be able to take part in a structured arts and craft session. We endeavour to make each session as exciting and interesting as possible, focusing on different themes every week. Below is an example of one of our study support sessions and arts and craft activity.



Literacy Session - Writing Instructions

Chicks (Foundation) - Ordering pictures for instructions- planting a sunflower.

Owlets (Key Stage 1) - Children will be introduced to their task; planting sunflower seeds. They will be given the materials needed to plant their sunflower seeds. They will be given the instructions on how to plant a sunflower and will read and follow them, putting them into order first.

Wise Owls (Key Stage 2) - Children will be introduced to their task; planting sunflower seeds. They will be given the materials needed to plant their sunflower seeds. They will write their own instructions on how to plant a sunflower using the Instructional Text Word Mat. They will be reminded about the type of language to use, to write what they need, to write the instructions in order and to add any diagrams that may help with the instructions.


Arts and Crafts Session - Owl Tubes

Children will be given coloured paper to roll into various sized tubes. They will be given different materials to decorate their 'owl tube', e.g feathers, foam, sequins etc. The finished owls will be added to our table tree display. www.funfamilytips.com
